## Map 0.2 GALL-PETERS PROJECTION (FIRST USED IN 1885, THEN PROMOTED AGAIN IN 1973)

The Gall-Peters Projection reflects the relative sizes of each area so that they can be accurately compared to one another. It is called an "equalarea" map. Notice how large Africa and South America are in comparison to Europe and North America, for example. The Gall-Peters map distorts shapes, however, so while the relative sizes are correct, the shapes are not.
